### Prevention Starts with Healthy Relationships

Healthy relationships involve respect, honesty, humility, and safety.

- Reference was made to 1 Corinthians 13 as a framework for discussing healthy relationships, emphasizing love, patience, kindness, truth, and protection.

Churches should create environments where individuals feel safe to disclose abuse or exploitation

- Part of the disclosures is understanding the laws in place to report abuse & exploitation.
- Create protocols for church staff and volunteers.

Let's add to the online safety conversation by creating meaningful relationships.

- Meaningful relationships that encourage honest conversations about uncomfortable topics are equally essential in prevention efforts.

Faith communities are uniquely positioned to provide prevention, support, and hope.

- Small, consistent actions by churches and community members can create long-term impact.
